IMPORTANT NOTICE

1. Under the provisions of the Customs Act 1967;
- Travellers entering Malaysia are required to declare all dutiable or prohibited goods in their possession.
 - Travellers are responsible for opening their baggage for Customs examination and for repacking their goods after examination.
 - It is an offence to make a false declaration and failure to declare dutiable or prohibited goods is also an offence.
 - Duty free exemption PER traveller: Wine, spirits or malt liquor not exceeding 1 litre in all. Tobacco not exceeding 225 grams (equivalent to 200 cigarettes). Soaps and dentifrices in open containers to a total value not exceeding RM200. New wearing apparels not exceeding 3 pieces. New footwear not exceeding one pair. Portable electrically or battery operated appliances for personal care and hygiene not exceeding 1 unit each. Dutiable food preparations to a total value not exceeding RM75. Gifts and souvenirs to a total value not exceeding RM200. (Conditions: Residents must have left the country not less than 72 hours while non-residents must have the intention to visit Malaysia not less than 72 hours).

PLEASE DECLARE ALL GOODS IN EXCESS OF THE DUTY FREE EXEMPTION

2. Under the Anti-Money Laundering and Anti-Terrorism Financing Act 2001 (AMLATFA), travellers entering or leaving Malaysia with cash and/or negotiable bearer instruments exceeding an amount equivalent to USD10,000 are required to make a declaration.

Negotiable bearer instruments include traveller's cheques, banker's drafts, bearer cheques, bills of exchange, promissory notes, postal orders and money orders.

Non-compliance with the above requirement is an offence under the AMLATFA and is punishable with a fine not exceeding RM1,000,000 or imprisonment for a term not exceeding one year or both.

3. Under the Exchange Control Act 1953, prior written permission from the Controller of Foreign Exchange is required for:

- Travellers entering or leaving Malaysia with ringgit notes exceeding RM1,000;
- Resident travellers leaving Malaysia with foreign currency notes and traveller's cheques exceeding an amount equivalent to USD10,000; and
- Non-resident travellers leaving Malaysia with foreign currency notes and traveller's cheques exceeding the amount bought in.

Enforcement of the above requirements is under the Customs Act 1967.
